This letter serves as confirmation that **Mr. R. - shall not misrepresent himself to clients or mislead clients in any way;
- shall take every reasonable step to ensure that his clients receive the services contracted for, and to ensure their safety, comfort and satisfaction; and
- shall not act in any manner that brings the good name of PHASA and its members into disrepute.

PHASA, founded in 1978, is firmly established as the mouthpiece and leading professional hunting authority in South Africa. The association is a recognized and accredited professional hunting association in terms of the Firearms Control Act 60 of 2000. SAPS Accreditation Registration Number 1300101.
